Aces Connections

• Head coach Natalie Nakase won consecutive WNBA Championships with the Aces in 2022 and 2023. Nakase was an assistant coach under Becky Hammon in Las Vegas from Feb. 2022 until Oct. 2024, when she was hired as the head coach of Golden State.

• Tiffany Hayes was tabbed the league's Sixth Player of the Year while with Las Vegas in 2024. The lefty shot a career-high 50.0 percent (minimum 150 FGA) from the field, and 40.2 percent from deep which ranked 10th in the W.

• Assistant Coach Ta'Shauna "Sugar" Rodgers spent 8 years in the WNBA and played her last 2 seasons with the Aces where she helped lead the 2020 team to the finals against the Storm with a three-point percentage of 35.7. Following the 2020 finals, she became the assistant coach for the Aces for one year and later an assistant coach with the Valkyries

• Valkyries center Kiah Stokes played for Las Vegas from 2021-2025, winning three WNBA Championships with the Aces.

• Aces forward Stephanie Talbot was selected by Golden State in the 2024 WNBA Expansion Draft, appearing in 16 games for the Valkyries this past season.

Notes

• Golden State had a 2025 season for the history books. The Valkyries set the record for wins by an expansion team (23), became the first-ever WNBA expansion team to reach the postseason during its inaugural season, and secured a winning record during its inaugural season.

• Golden State won its 17th game of the year on 8/13/25, tying them with the 1998 Detroit Shock for the most of any WNBA expansion team (excluding the 1997 WNBA inaugural season). The Shock reached 17 wins in 30 games (their final game of the season), while the Valkyries accomplished the feat in 32 games.

• Newly-signed free agents Kiah Stokes and Gabby Williams played together at UConn during the 2014-15 season, leading the Huskies to a 38-1 record and the National Championship title. Stokes also won a pair of WNBA Championships under then-assistant coach Natalie Nakase while in Las Vegas.

• Kaitlyn Chen, Tiffany Hayes, Kiah Stokes and Gabby Williams give the Valkyries four former UConn players on the roster, the most former Huskies on any roster in the WNBA.

• Valkyries assistant coach Sugar Rodgers and Valkyries center Kiah Stokes suited up together with the Liberty from 2015-2018, rooming together on road trips.

• Veronica Burton has had quite the year on the court. After being named the WNBA Kia Most Improved Player of the Year and WNBA All-Defensive Second Team, Burton's offseason consisted of an Unrivaled title with the Mist, and swept Courtney Williams 11-0 during Unrivaled's 1-on-1 tournament. Burton also won gold with Team USA at the 2025 FIBA 3x3 AmeriCup, and bronze at the 2026 USA 3x3 Champions Cup. She also participated in the December 2025 Women's National Team Training Camp in Durham, North Carolina, and the April 2026 Women's National Team Training Camp in Phoenix, alongside fellow Valkyries Kayla Thornton and Natalie Nakase who served as a court coach.

• The Valkyries boast the most returners this year of any other WNBA team, bringing back nine players who saw minutes in a Golden State uniform from a year ago.

• Veronica Burton is picking up where she left off last season, posting 12 assists to go with 13 points and zero turnovers in the win over Phoenix this past Sunday, her fourth game with double-digit assists and no turnovers which is tied for the second-most all-time in WNBA history; trailing just Sue Bird's 7. It took Bird 266 regular season games to register her fourth instance of 10+ assists and 0 turnovers, and Burton just 153 games.

• Gabby Williams suited up alongside Justé Jocyte at LDLC ASVEL Feminin Lyon in 2023, where the pair helped lead the club to a EuroCup title.

• On Tuesday, against Portland, the Valkyries broke the team record for

threes in a half with 12 in the first (one away from the WNBA all-time record), and threes in a game with 18, the most made threes by any team in the league this season. The Valkyries shot 45.0 percent (18-40) from three, the second-straight game they've shot 45.0 percent or better from beyond the arc. Kayla Thornton went 5-10 from three, marking the first time in her career she's posted four made threes in back-to-back games after going 4-7 on May 31 against Las Vegas. Golden State posted 35 points in the second quarter, the second-most points scored in any quarter by the team, and 56 points in the first half which is tied for the second most in any half in team history. The Valkyries tied their season high with 25 assists, and assisted on 16 of 18 threes.

• Dating back to the start of 2025, Gabby Williams' 117 total steals and 2.17 SPG far and away lead the WNBA. Veronica Burton has 323 assists over that span, the second most in the league trailing just Alyssa Thomas' 440, and her 2.96 assist-to-turnover ratio is also second best. Burton's six points-assists double-doubles from 2025 to date are the third most in the league, and her 87.1 FT% is fourth best in the W (min. 150 made)

• Against the Fever on 5/28 Veronica Burton became the first guard since Diana Taurasi in 2008 to post 25 points, six rebounds and five blocks in a game.

• Veronica Burton is ninth in the W with 5.8 assists per game, and 10th with a 3.87 assist-to-turnover ratio. Burton is posting a league-best 10.75 a/to in wins this season, while Tiffany Hayes is second in the league with a 10.00 a/to in victories in 2026. Burton is also 11th in the W with a +6.4.

• Kiah Stokes is seventh in the WNBA with a 4.67 a/to, and leads all centers in the category.

• Gabby Williams' 1.8 SPG is the tied-for-sixth best in the WNBA, and her 36.0 steal percentage is 11th best.

• With 15 points against the Lynx, Tiffany Hayes passed Maya Moore for 31st on the league's all-time scoring list. Hayes now has 4,985 points, the 10th most among active players, and is 15 points away from 5,000. Hayes will become the 21st player all time with at least 5,000 points, 900 assists and 300 steals in their career.

• Justé Jocyte is shooting 45.5 percent from three this season, and getting 71.4 percent of her points from three-point range. The guard has made a three in four of five games she's played in this season.

• The Valkyries are posting a +/- of +10.3, as well as a 40.9 3FG% on one day of rest this season (2-1 record).

• Golden State's 103.4 defensive rating is fifth best in the W, and its 7.5 net rating is third best in the WNBA.

• The Valkyries are 5-1 when Veronica Burton has five or more assists in an game this season.

• Four Valkyries players (Burton - 13.6, Chen - 7.1, Salaün - 14.2) Williams - 13.3) are averaging career highs in points.

• Janelle Salaün's 2.7 made threes per game are the fifth-most in the WNBA

• The Valkyries are allowing just 80.1 points per game, which is third in the W. Additionally, opponents are averaging just 9.5 points off turnovers, and 30.0 points in the paint, both of which are No. 1 in the W. In four road games this season, Golden State is turning the ball over just 9.0 times per game, best in the league.

• Natalie Nakase's next win will be the 30th of her career.

• The Valkyries are posting a 1.96 a/to ratio on the year (second best in the W). Four players rank in the top 20 in a/to ratio (No. 7 Stokes - 4.67; No. 10 Burton - 3.87; No. 14 Hayes - 3.20; No. 18 Chen - 2.86).

• The Valkyries currently rank first in the league in total threes (124) made threes per game (12.4), and in 3FG% (38.9). SAN FRANCISCO -- — A'ja Wilson had 28 points, 15 rebounds and four blocks, Jackie Young added 23 points and nine assists, and the Las Vegas Aces beat the Golden State Valkyries 91-81 on Sunday.

The victory was the 150th of Becky Hammon's coaching career, and it made her the second-fastest coach to reach the milestone. Hammon did it in 205 games — seven behind Van Chancellor's record set when he coached the Houston Comets.

Young made 9 of 17 from the field, 5 of 9 from 3-point range, and grabbed seven rebounds. NaLyssa Smith had 15 points and nine rebounds for the Aces (5-3), the defending WNBA champions.

Gabby Williams led the Valkyries (5-3) with 20 points, Janelle Salaun added 16 and Kayla Thornton 12.

Las Vegas led 43-41 at halftime before Wilson had 13 points and Young 11 in the third quarter as the Aces outscored Golden State 29-13 to take an 18-point lead into the fourth. The Valkyries made just 3 of 17 (18%) from the field and committed five turnovers in the period.

Williams hit a 3-pointer that capped and 11-0 run and trimmed Golden State's deficit to 85-74 with 1:52 left in the game. Salaun made two free throws and then hit a 3 that made it an eight-point game about a minute later, but the Valkyries never got closer.

The Valkyries, who went into the game allowing a WNBA-low 78 points per game, gave up a season-high 91 points.

Golden State's Veronica Burton went to the bench with about 3 1/2 minutes remaining and was in obvious discomfort as she grabbed at her left thigh. The team's leading scorer at 15.9 per game, Burton had seven points and five assists. There was no immediate word on the extent of her injury.

Chennedy Carter took a couple of hard falls in the first half, walked slowly to locker room at halftime and played just one minute in the third quarter before leaving the game. Carter finished with six points in nine minutes.

HEAD COACH NATALIE NAKASE



SCHOOL: UCLA - '03 **EXPERIENCE:** 2nd Season

Natalie Nakase is in her second season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces.

Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

In her first season at the helm of the Valkyries, Nakase led Golden State to 23 regular season wins during its inaugural year, a WNBA single-season record by an expansion team, and the Valkyries became the first-ever expansion franchise to reach the playoffs in their inaugural season. In June 2025, Nakase was named the league's Coach of the Month after the Valkyries went 7-4 (.636), and had three wins by 24 points or more.

Under Nakase and her staff, the Valkyries posted one of the best defenses in the WNBA, leading the league in opponent points per game (76.3) and opponent field goal percentage (40.5), while having the third-best defensive rating (99.8). Offensively, Golden State ranked top five in the WNBA in rebounds per game (35.3), three pointers made (427), and free throw percentage (81.5) during the regular season.

Following the season, Nakase was named the 2025 State Street Investment Management SPY WNBA Coach of the Year as well as the Associated Press Coach of the Year. Under Nakase's leadership, many Valkyries reached new career heights during the 2025 season, including Veronica Burton, who earned 2025 Kia WNBA Most Improved Player honors, Kayla Thornton, who was selected as a WNBA All-Star, and Janelle Salaün, who was named to the WNBA All-Rookie Team.

Nakase spent three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in 2023, with a rating of 97.7. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). She then served as an assistant coach for the Tokyo Apache for one season (2010-11) in the Men's Professional Basketball Japan League, followed by acting as head coach for the Saitama Broncos from 2011-12, making her the first woman to serve as head coach in the league.

Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology. After graduation, she played professionally for two years in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) with the San Jose Spiders and San Diego Siege. Nakase also competed for one season in Germany, where she suffered a career-ending knee injury in 2008.

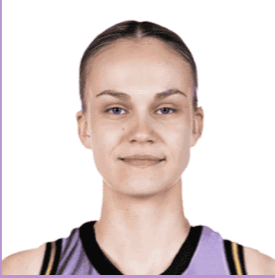
