• Laeticia Amihere and Sania Feagin played together from 2021-2023 at the University of South Carolina, winning the 2022 NCAA National Championship while going 35-2.

• Sparks guard Kate Martin was Golden State's selection in the 2024 WNBA expansion draft. Martin played in 42 games for the Valkyries last season, averaging 6.2 points, 2.7 rebounds and 1.0 assists per game. Martin also played under then-assistant coach Natalie Nakase in 2024 while with Las Vegas.

• LA's Cameron Brink and Golden State's Ashten Prechtel led Stanford to the 2021 NCAA title.

Notes

• On June 7, the Valkyries signed 6-4 center Nadia Fingall. Fingall played for Valencia in Spain from 2023-2025, leading her team to two Liga Femenina de Baloncesto titles and two Supercopa de España championships while earning MVP honors in 2024, and for Casademont Zaragoza where she averaged 8.7 points, 5.7 rebounds and a 44.7 field goal percentage in 19 games en route to a bronze medal in the Final Six. Fingall played collegiately at Stanford where she was named Pac-12 All-Defensive Team Honorable Mention in 2020. Fingall appeared in 115 games across four seasons with the Cardinal, averaging 5.1 points and 3.9 rebounds while shooting 47.9 percent from the floor.

• Golden State had a 2025 season for the history books. The Valkyries set the record for wins by an expansion team (23), became the first-ever WNBA expansion team to reach the postseason during its inaugural season, and secured a winning record during its inaugural season.

• Kaitlyn Chen, Tiffany Hayes, Kiah Stokes and Gabby Williams give the Valkyries four former UConn players on the roster, the most former Huskies on any roster in the WNBA.

• The Valkyries boast the most returners this year of any other WNBA team, bringing back nine players who saw minutes in a Golden State uniform from a year ago.

• Veronica Burton is picking up where she left off last season, posting 12 assists to go with 13 points and zero turnovers in the win over Phoenix this past Sunday, her fourth game with double-digit assists and no turnovers which is tied for the second-most all-time in WNBA history; trailing just Sue Bird's 7. It took Bird 266 regular season games to register her fourth instance of 10+ assists and 0 turnovers, and Burton just 153 games.

• Gabby Williams suited up alongside Justè Jocyté at LDLC ASVEL Feminin Lyon in 2023, where the pair helped lead the club to a EuroCup title.

• Dating back to the start of 2025, Gabby Williams' 121 total steals and 2.12 SPG far and away lead the WNBA. Veronica Burton has 342 assists over that span, the second most in the league trailing just Alyssa Thomas' 471, her 2.97 assist-to-turnover ratio is the best, and her 37.1 assist percentage is second best. Burton's six points-assists double-doubles from 2025 to date are the third most in the league.

• Against the Fever on 5/28 Veronica Burton became the first guard since Diana Taurasi in 2008 to post 25 points, six rebounds and five blocks in a game.

• On Tuesday's game against Phoenix, Gabby Williams scored 25 points, marking the first time she has scored 20+ points in back-to-back games in her career. Veronica Burton also added 25 points, the first time two Valkyries players have scored 20+ in the same game.

• Veronica Burton is eighth in the W with 5.9 assists per game, and sixth with a 3.67 assist-to-turnover ratio. Burton is posting a 6.56 a/to in wins this season (second highest in the W). Golden State is 7-0 this season when Burton has six or more assists. The Valkyries are the only team in the league with two players in the top ten in a/to (Burton and No. 6 Stokes - 3.80).

• Laeticia Amihere leads the team and is 16th in the W with a +5.7 +/-, while Veronica Burton is 20th with a +5.3, and Kayla Thornton is 31st with a +4.2.

• Kiah Stokes is sixth in the WNBA with a 3.80 a/to, and leads all centers in the category. Golden State is 3-0 when Stokes registers three or more assists this season.

• Gabby Williams' 1.7 SPG is seventh-best in the WNBA, and her 33.3 steal percentage is 13th best. Williams has recorded a steal in seven straight games.

• With 15 points against the Lynx on 6/4, Tiffany Hayes passed Maya Moore for 31st on the league's all-time scoring list. In Seattle this past Friday, Tiffany Hayes reached 5,000 career points on an and-one free throw in the second quarter, becoming the 21st player all time with at least 5,000 points, 900 assists, and 300 steals in their career.

• Janelle Salaün became the ninth-fastest player all-time to reach 100 career threes (49 games) on 6/12 against Seattle. Salaün has made five threes in three games this season, and is t-third in the W with 37 total threes. Salaün is fourth in the league with a 40.2 3FG% (among players with at least 5.0 3PA per game).

• Justè Jocyté is shooting 45.5 percent from three this season, and getting 71.4 percent of her points from three-point range. The guard has made a three in four of five games she's played in this season.

• Golden State is one of two teams (Minnesota) top five in both offensive rating (No.4 - 110.0) and defensive rating (No. 5 - 103.7). Los Angeles is third in offensive rating (110.2).

• The Valkyries are posting a league-best 1.95 assists-to-turnover ratio in home games this season. Opponents are averaging just 79.8 PPG and 5.2 SPG at Ballhalla this season (both best in the W). GSV opponents are shooting 42.5 percent against at Chase Center this season, third lowest in the league.

• Four Valkyries players (Burton - 14.4, Chen - 5.5, Salaün - 14.3, Williams - 15.7) are averaging career highs in points. Williams is one of five players in the league this season averaging over 15.0 PPG and 1.5 SPG. Burton is one of seven players averaging over 14.0 PPG and 5.5 APG.

• The Valkyries are allowing just 79.8 points per game, which is tied-for-first in the W. Additionally, opponents are posting just 5.2 steals per game and 29.2 points in the paint per game, both the fewest in the league.

• Golden State is 7-1 this season when leading after three quarters, and are 2-0 when winning the rebounding battle.

• The Valkyries currently rank first in the league in total threes (153) and made threes per game (11.8), and are third in 3FG% (36.4). Golden State is leading the W with 12.3 made threes per game in wins, while shooting 37.0 from beyond the arc in victories. 41.5 percent of Golden State's points come from three. The Valkyries are 6-3 this season when making double-digit threes. The WNBA record for made threes in a game is 11.1 (NYL in 2023), and threes in a season is 444 (NYL in 2023), the Valkyries are on pace for roughly 540 threes.

• GSV is averaging 34.8 PPG (best in the league), as well as a 39.5 3FG%, from the bench which is second best in the WNBA. Janelle Salaün ranks third (13.7 PPG) in the WNBA in bench points per game. The Valkyries have gotten 30 or more bench points in nine of 12 games this season. Golden State is 4-1 when getting 40-or-more bench points in a game this year.

Veronica Burton

The WNBA's reigning Most Improved Player, Veronica Burton has started every single game in Valkyries history. Burton ranks second on the team with 14.4 PPG and first with 5.9 APG. The Northwestern product has led the team in scoring twice, and led the team in assists in 11 of 13 games this season. On May 10, Burton recorded her fourth career 10+assists and 0 turnover game which is tied for the second-most in WNBA history (trailing Sue Bird's 7), and its the most assists (12) without a turnover recorded in a game this season.

HEAD COACH NATALIE NAKASE



SCHOOL: UCLA - '03 **EXPERIENCE:** 2nd Season

Natalie Nakase is in her second season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces.

Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

In her first season at the helm of the Valkyries, Nakase led Golden State to 23 regular season wins during its inaugural year, a WNBA single-season record by an expansion team, and the Valkyries became the first-ever expansion franchise to reach the playoffs in their inaugural season. In June 2025, Nakase was named the league's Coach of the Month after the Valkyries went 7-4 (.636), and had three wins by 24 points or more.

Under Nakase and her staff, the Valkyries posted one of the best defenses in the WNBA, leading the league in opponent points per game (76.3) and opponent field goal percentage (40.5), while having the third-best defensive rating (99.8). Offensively, Golden State ranked top five in the WNBA in rebounds per game (35.3), three pointers made (427), and free throw percentage (81.5) during the regular season.

Following the season, Nakase was named the 2025 State Street Investment Management SPY WNBA Coach of the Year as well as the Associated Press Coach of the Year. Under Nakase's leadership, many Valkyries reached new career heights during the 2025 season, including Veronica Burton, who earned 2025 Kia WNBA Most Improved Player honors, Kayla Thornton, who was selected as a WNBA All-Star, and Janelle Salaün, who was named to the WNBA All-Rookie Team.

Nakase spent three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in 2023, with a rating of 97.7. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). She then served as an assistant coach for the Tokyo Apache for one season (2010-11) in the Men's Professional Basketball Japan League, followed by acting as head coach for the Saitama Broncos from 2011-12, making her the first woman to serve as head coach in the league.

Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology. After graduation, she played professionally for two years in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) with the San Jose Spiders and San Diego Siege. Nakase also competed for one season in Germany, where she suffered a career-ending knee injury in 2008.
