Aces Connections

• Head coach Natalie Nakase won consecutive WNBA Championships with the Aces in 2022 and 2023. Nakase was an assistant coach under Becky Hammon in Las Vegas from Feb. 2022 until Oct. 2024, when she was hired as the head coach of Golden State.

• Tiffany Hayes was tabbed the league's Sixth Player of the Year while with Las Vegas in 2024. The lefty shot a career-high 50.0 percent (minimum 150 FGA) from the field, and 40.2 percent from deep which ranked 10th in the W.

• Assistant Coach Ta'Shauna "Sugar" Rodgers spent 8 years in the WNBA and played her last 2 seasons with the Aces where she helped lead the 2020 team to the finals against the Storm with a three-point percentage of 35.7. Following the 2020 finals, she became the assistant coach for the Aces for one year and later an assistant coach with the Valkyries

• Valkyries center Kiah Stokes played for Las Vegas from 2021-2025, winning three WNBA Championships with the Aces.

• Aces forward Stephanie Talbot was selected by Golden State in the 2024 WNBA Expansion Draft, appearing in 16 games for the Valkyries this past season.

Notes

• On June 7, the Valkyries signed 6-4 center Nadia Fingall. Fingall played for Valencia in Spain from 2023-2025, leading her team to two Liga Femenina de Baloncesto titles and two Supercopa de España championships while earning MVP honors in 2024, and for Casademont Zaragoza where she averaged 8.7 points, 5.7 rebounds and a 44.7 field goal percentage in 19 games en route to a bronze medal in the Final Six. Fingall played collegiately at Stanford where she was named Pac-12 All-Defensive Team Honorable Mention in 2020. Fingall appeared in 115 games across four seasons with the Cardinal, averaging 5.1 points and 3.9 rebounds while shooting 47.9 percent from the floor.

• Golden State had a 2025 season for the history books. The Valkyries set the record for wins by an expansion team (23), became the first-ever WNBA expansion team to reach the postseason during its inaugural season, and secured a winning record during its inaugural season.

• Kaitlyn Chen, Tiffany Hayes, Kiah Stokes and Gabby Williams give the Valkyries four former UConn players on the roster, the most former Huskies on any roster in the WNBA.

• The Valkyries boast the most returners this year of any other WNBA team, bringing back nine players who saw minutes in a Golden State uniform from a year ago.

• The WNBA announced the results of the first fan returns for the All-Star game, with forward Gabby Williams ranking eighth and guard Veronica Burton ranking 31st. The four guards and six frontcourt players with the best score will be named as starters. Once the starters have been determined, the league's head coaches will select the 12 reserves. The 15 head coaches will vote for three guards, five frontcourt players and four players at either position regardless of conference. Coaches may not vote for players on their own team.

• Veronica Burton is picking up where she left off last season, posting 12 assists to go with 13 points and zero turnovers in the win over Phoenix this past Sunday, her fourth game with double-digit assists and no turnovers which is tied for the second-most all-time in WNBA history; trailing just Sue Bird's 7. It took Bird 266 regular season games to register her fourth instance of 10+ assists and 0 turnovers, and Burton just 153 games.

• Against the Fever on 5/28 Veronica Burton became the first guard since Diana Taurasi in 2008 to post 25 points, six rebounds and five blocks in a game.

• In last Tuesday's game against Phoenix, Gabby Williams scored 25 points, marking the first time she has scored 20+ points in back-to-back games in her career. Veronica Burton also added 25 points, the first time two Valkyries players have scored 20+ in the same game.

• Against the Wings on June 17, the Valkyries held Dallas to just seven points in the second quarter, the fewest points allowed by Golden State in any quarter in team history. Golden State outscored Dallas 27-7 in the frame,

highlighted by a 19-0 run, and held the Wings to just 2-15 (13.3 percent) from the floor. Five Valkyries scored in double figures for the third time this season (3-0 record in those games).

• Golden State has the 6th toughest strength of schedule remaining in the WNBA, with opponents boasting a combined .506 winning percentage. The Valkyries have the second-toughest SoS in the western conference, trailing Seattle.

• Golden State is allowing a WNBA-low 78.6 PPG, including just 73.0 PPG its last three games (next best is Minnesota's 77.3 PPG their last three contests). Valkyries opponents are shooting just 40.1 percent from the floor, averaging 17.7 assists, the last three games. GSV's 95.6 defensive rating the last three games is second best in the league.

• The Valkyries are 4-1 when outrebounding their opponent, and 8-1 when they dish out more assists than their opponent.

• Veronica Burton is t-eighth in the W with 5.6 assists per game, and t-fifth with a 3.33 assist-to-turnover ratio. Burton is posting a 5.15 a/to in wins this season (fifth highest in the W). The Valkyries as a team are second in the league with a 1.79 assist-to-turnover ratio, and that mark increases to 2.09 in victories. Golden State is 4-1 this year when posting 15 or more assists while also only committing single-digit turnovers.

• Veronica Burton is one of nine players in the W averaging over 13.0 points and 5.5 assists this season. Gabby Williams is one of four players posting over 15.0 PPG and 1.5 SPG in 2026. Golden State is 7-0 this season when Burton has six or more assists.

• Kiah Stokes is 13th in the WNBA with a 2.86 a/to, and leads all centers in the category. Stokes is sixth among WNBA centers in defensive rating at 98.2, and leads all centers in pace at 92.59. Stokes is a key reason why Golden State leads the WNBA in allowing the fewest points in the paint at just 30.0.

• Gabby Williams ranks t-fourth in the WNBA with 21.2 PPG her last six games. The All-Star has four 20-point games this season (tied for her career high for most in a year).

• With 15 points against the Lynx on 6/4, Tiffany Hayes passed Maya Moore for 31st on the league's all-time scoring list. In Seattle on June 12, Tiffany Hayes reached 5,000 career points on an and-one free throw in the second quarter, becoming the 21st player all time with at least 5,000 points, 900 assists, and 300 steals in their career.

• Janelle Salaün became the ninth-fastest player all-time to reach 100 career threes (49 games) on 6/12 against Seattle. Salaün has made five threes in three games this season, and is t-second in the W with 43 total threes on the year. Salaün is sixth in the league with a 38.7 3FG% (among players with at least 5.0 3PA per game). The Valkyries are 3-1 when Salaün makes four or more threes in a game this year.

• Golden State ranks top second in the W in defensive rating (102.2), and lead the league in first-half defensive rating (94.5). The Valkyries are allowing a league-low 35.6 PPG in the first half of games this season, including a league-low 17.3 PPG in the second quarter. Golden State opponents are shooting just 39.7 percent from the field in the first half of games.

• Four Valkyries players (Burton - 13.4, Chen - 6.2, Salaün - 13.8, Williams - 16.3) are averaging career highs in points.

The Valkyries defense held the Sparks to just 33.3 percent (20-60) from the field and 14.3 percent (3-21) from three, both season lows by Golden State.

• Golden State is 9-1 this season when tied or leading after three quarters.

• GSV is averaging 34.5 PPG, as well as a 39.7 3FG% and 4.8 made threes from the bench, all of which are the best in the WNBA. Janelle Salaün ranks second (13.8 PPG) in the WNBA in bench points per game. The Valkyries have gotten 30 or more bench points in 11 games this season. Golden State is 5-1 when getting 40-or-more bench points in a game this year.

• The Valkyries currently rank first in the league in total threes (184) and made threes per game (11.5), and are second in 3FG% (36.4). LAS VEGAS -- — A’ja Wilson had 28 points and 14 rebounds, Jackie Young hit 6 of 8 from 3-point range and finished with a season-high 27 points, and the Las Vegas Aces beat the Golden State Valkyries 84-79 on Saturday for their first home victory of the season.

Chelsea Gray added 12 points, six rebounds and six assists for Las Vegas. Gray has 1,134 assists and moved past current Aces coach Becky Hammon (1,133) into first place on the franchise’s career assist list.

Wilson had her third consecutive double-double and her fifth this season.
The Aces (7-3), the defending WNBA champions, have won three straight following back-to-back losses.

Gabby Williams scored a career-high 27 points on 10-of-17 shooting for the Valkyries (6-5). Veronica Burton added 15 points, Janelle Salaun scored 11 and Kayla Thornton had 10.

Wilson hit a jumper from the left with 52.9 seconds left, Burton answered with a layup and Young made a pull-up 3-pointer with 24.2 seconds left to give the Aces a two-point lead. Young and Wilson each made two free throws to seal it.

Williams made a layup to open the scoring, Golden State’s only lead until Tiffany Hayes hit a 3-pointer that made it 61-58 with 8:48 left in the game.
Golden State scored 14 of the final 19 first-half points and trailed 38-35 at halftime. Wilson outscored the Valkyries 14-13 in the first quarter as the Aces took a seven-point lead. Thornton and Salaun each made two of Golden State’s five second-quarter 3s.

Veronica Burton

The WNBA's reigning Most Improved Player, Veronica Burton has started every single game in Valkyries history. Burton ranks third on the team with 13.4 PPG and first with 5.6 APG. The Northwestern product has led the team in scoring twice, and led the team in assists in 13 of 16 games this season. On May 10, Burton recorded her fourth career 10+assists and 0 turnover game which is tied for the second-most in WNBA history (trailing Sue Bird's 7), and its the most assists (12) without a turnover recorded in a game this season.

This season, Burton is currently averaging career highs in points (13.4), blocks (0.8), and three-point field goal percentage (35.7).

The UConn alumna is shooting a career-best 37.5 percent from three while averaging a career-high 2.1 made threes per game.

Thornton has scored in double figures in eight games this season, while leading the team in rebounding in six games this season. On 5/21 versus New York Thornton recorded her 300th career regular-season game on 5/21 in New York, making her the eighth undrafted player since 2000 or later to have appeared in 300+ regular season games. Thornton's 2,374 career points are the sixth most in WNBA history among undrafted players that debuted since 2000.

HEAD COACH NATALIE NAKASE



SCHOOL: UCLA - '03 **EXPERIENCE:** 2nd Season

Natalie Nakase is in her second season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces.

Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

In her first season at the helm of the Valkyries, Nakase led Golden State to 23 regular season wins during its inaugural year, a WNBA single-season record by an expansion team, and the Valkyries became the first-ever expansion franchise to reach the playoffs in their inaugural season. In June 2025, Nakase was named the league's Coach of the Month after the Valkyries went 7-4 (.636), and had three wins by 24 points or more.

Under Nakase and her staff, the Valkyries posted one of the best defenses in the WNBA, leading the league in opponent points per game (76.3) and opponent field goal percentage (40.5), while having the third-best defensive rating (99.8). Offensively, Golden State ranked top five in the WNBA in rebounds per game (35.3), three pointers made (427), and free throw percentage (81.5) during the regular season.

Following the season, Nakase was named the 2025 State Street Investment Management SPY WNBA Coach of the Year as well as the Associated Press Coach of the Year. Under Nakase's leadership, many Valkyries reached new career heights during the 2025 season, including Veronica Burton, who earned 2025 Kia WNBA Most Improved Player honors, Kayla Thornton, who was selected as a WNBA All-Star, and Janelle Salaün, who was named to the WNBA All-Rookie Team.

Nakase spent three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in 2023, with a rating of 97.7. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). She then served as an assistant coach for the Tokyo Apache for one season (2010-11) in the Men's Professional Basketball Japan League, followed by acting as head coach for the Saitama Broncos from 2011-12, making her the first woman to serve as head coach in the league.

Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology. After graduation, she played professionally for two years in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) with the San Jose Spiders and San Diego Siege. Nakase also competed for one season in Germany, where she suffered a career-ending knee injury in 2008.
