Mercury Connections

• Mercury head coach Nate Tippetts coached Golden State assistant coach Kasib Powell for the Sioux Falls Skyforce of the NBA D-League in 2007.

• Phoenix's Valerieanne Ayayi & Noemie Brochant, and Golden State's Janelle Salaün & Iliana Rupert all represented France at the 2025 FIBA Women's EuroBasket. The four make up a third of the 12 French-born players in the WNBA.

• Valkyries forward-guard Kaila Charles and Phoenix forward Alyssa Thomas both played collegiately at Maryland. Charles played for the Terrapins from 2016-20, while Thomas' college career spanned from 2010-14.

• Golden State guard Miela Sowah and Phoenix guard Sami Whitcomb both hail from Australia and have represented their country on the international stage.

• Phoenix's Alyssa Thomas and DeWanna Bonner teamed up with Valkyries forward-guard Kaila Charles on the Connecticut Sun from 2020-21.

• Valkyries head coach Natalie Nakase and Mercury head coach Nate Tippetts both served as assistant coaches for team USA at the 2026 FIBA World Cup Qualifying Tournament in Puerto Rico in March.

Notes

• Golden State had a 2025 season for the history books. The Valkyries set the record for wins by an expansion team (23), became the first-ever WNBA expansion team to reach the postseason during its inaugural season, and secured a winning record during its inaugural season.

• Kaitlyn Chen, Tiffany Hayes, Kiah Stokes and Gabby Williams give the Valkyries four former UConn players on the roster, the most former Huskies on any roster in the WNBA.

• The Valkyries boast the most returners this year of any other WNBA team, bringing back nine players who saw minutes in a Golden State uniform from a year ago.

• Gabby Williams recently represented Golden State at the 2026 WNBA All-Star game, becoming the first starter in team history. Williams scored 18 points while adding five rebounds and six assists to go with one steal in the contest for Team Coop.

• The Valkyries' 11 home wins are tied for the most in the WNBA, and their 73.3 home winning percentage is the best in the league.

• Golden State has the easiest strength of schedule remaining, with opponents boasting a 45.4 winning percentage.

• Golden State is allowing a WNBA-low 76.4 PPG on the year, including just 71.3 PPG its last 10 games (9-1 record; next best team (WAS) during this stretch is allowing 80.0 PPG). Valkyries opponents are shooting just 40.9 percent from the floor, and 29.1 percent from deep the last 10 games (both league lows). The Valkyries have allowed 70 or fewer points nine times this season, including five times in the last 10 games.

• The Valkyries are 9-1 their last 10 games, including nine straight. The team's nine-game win streak is the longest in the WNBA this season, as well as the longest in team history.

• Golden State's defensive rating of 100.9 is the best in the W, and have a WNBA-best 97.3 defensive rating the month of July. GSV opponents are posting just 72.1 PPG this month.

• The Valkyries are allowing a league-low 34.4 PPG in the first half of games this season, including 15.9 PPG and 35.9 FG% in the second quarter, both league bests. Golden State opponents are shooting just 39.6 percent from the field in the first half of games (lowest in the league). The Valkyries are 17-4 this year when allowing 40 points or fewer in the first half this season.

• On the road, Golden State is conceding a league-low 76.8 PPG this season, including just 71.3 PPG their last five games on the road. The Valkyries are the second team in WNBA history to win five out of five on the road, joining the 2021 Seattle Storm who went 5-0 away from home between June 9-17 (per Elias).

• The Valkyries are 14-1 when they dish out more assists than their opponent, and, 12-1 when Veronica Burton hands out six or more assists in a game. Golden State's 68.4 assist percentage in wins is the third highest in the league.

• Veronica Burton is ninth in the W with 5.5 assists per game, and seventh with a 3.24 assist-to-turnover ratio. Burton is posting a 4.07 a/to in wins this season (eighth in the W). Burton is the only player in the W this season averaging over 11.0 PPG, 5.0 APG while posting no more than 2.0 turnovers per game. Burton is tied for the third most points-assists double-doubles since the start of the 2025 season with seven (trailing Alyssa Thomas (20) and Caitlin Clark (11), tied with Jordin Canada).

• Kaitlyn Chen is shooting 57.5 percent from the floor (eighth best in the league), including 63.1 percent her last 10 games. Chen's 5.74 PPG improvement from a year ago is 13th best in the league.

• Salaün leads all bench players in total points (345) while Chen ranks fourth (209), giving the pair a league-high combined 554 points on the year. The duo have combined for 219 points off the bench the last 10 games (21.9 PPG combined).

• Kiah Stokes is second in the league with 1.8 BPG (trailing just A'ja Wilson), and leads all centers with a 2.46 a/to. Stokes is third in the position with a defensive rating of 97.4. Stokes is one of 31 players all-time with over 1,000 points, 300 blocks and 200 assists, including one of 10 active players. Stokes leads all WNBA players with 2.3 BPG the last 10 games.

• Laetitia Amihire is third in the league with a defensive rating of 94.7 (min 10 GP). Stokes and Amihire are key reasons why Golden State leads the WNBA in allowing the fewest points in the paint at just 32.4.

• Janelle Salaün became the ninth-fastest player all-time to reach 100 career threes (49 games) on 6/12 against Seattle. Salaün has made five threes in four games this season, and is 1-fifth in the W with 67 total threes on the year (also is No. 1 among bench players). Salaün is third in the league with a 39.4 3FG% (among players with at least 5.0 3PA per game and 5 GP), and leads all bench players in the category (min. 5 GP). The Valkyries are 5-1 when Salaün makes four or more threes in a game this year.

• Janelle Salaün has already drained the second-most three-pointers by a reserve player in a season in league history with 67, trailing Shanna Zolman's record of 68 which she made in 2007. Her average of 2.48 made threes per game is currently a WNBA record by a reserve player. Additionally, Salaün's 12.8 PPG off the bench is currently the seventh best in league history. The WNBA record for bench points per game in a season is 15.8 by Candice Wiggins in 2008.

• Golden State is 14-2 this season when tied or leading after three quarters.

• GSV continues to lead the league in bench points at 35.4 PPG, 4.4 made threes per game, and is second in the W with a 37.1 3FG% from the bench. Janelle Salaün's 12.8 PPG leads the WNBA in bench points per game (min 5 GP). The Valkyries have gotten 30 or more bench points in 18 games this season. Golden State is 8-2 when getting 40-or-more bench points in a game this year. The WNBA record for bench points per game in a season is 35.0 (LVA - 2020).

• The Valkyries currently rank first in the league in total threes (286) and in made threes per game (10.6), and are sixth in 3FG% (34.7), and are second in first half threes per game (5.6). Golden State is averaging 11.1 made threes per game at home (highest in the league). A league-high 38.6 percent of Golden State's points come from three (currently the highest mark in league history - next best is 38.4 in 2021 by NYL). The Valkyries are 11-5 this season when making double-digit threes. The WNBA record for average made threes in a game is 11.1 (NYL in 2023), and threes in a season is 444 (NYL in 2023).
• Additionally, Golden State is third in the league with a 38.3 FG% from 25-29 feet out.

• Development player activations: Miela Sowah - 3 (5/8, 5/10, 5/21); Ashten Prechtel - 3 (5/13, 5/25, 5/28)

• Golden State is 6-1 (85.7) the month of July, the second best winning percentage in the month trailing just Dallas (87.5).

• Janelle Salaün is 11th in the league with 58 NET points, while Gabby Williams ranks 21st with 36 and Veronica Burton is 24th with 30th. Salaün's 5.1 NET per 80 possessions is fifth highest in the league.

• Golden State is the only team with 6 players in the top 25 of defensive win share (min 10 GP): No. 1 Burton - 0.194, No. 5 Thornton - 0.171, No. 10 Williams - 0.159, No. 14 Stokes - 0.150, No. 22 Charles - 0.130, No. 25 Zandalasini - 0.117.

• The win on 7/10 against Connecticut was Golden State's 40th win in franchise history. The Valkyries accomplished the feat in 68 games to become the fastest-ever expansion team to reach 40 victories.

• At 9-1 their last 10 games, including nine straight wins, the Valkyries are the hottest team coming out of the All-Star break.

• By the numbers the last 10 games (rankings based on last 10 games for all W teams)

SAN FRANCISCO -- — Veronica Burton scored 19 of her 25 points in the first half as Golden State quickly built a big lead and also dished out eight assists, Gabby Williams added 25 points, and the Valkyries held off the Phoenix Mercury for an 87-81 win Tuesday night.

Burton made 5 of her 7 shots in the initial two quarters and finished 7 for 15 from the floor. Janelle Salaun contributed 11 points and five rebounds off the bench for the Valkyries, who shot 57.1% on the way to a 49-32 lead at intermission and 44.3% for the game.

Williams' 3-pointer with 5:58 to play put the Valkyries ahead 74-67, then she found Kaila Charles for a key layup with 2:26 left. Kayla Thornton's 3 the next time down helped seal it before Williams converted a three-point play moments later.

Golden State guard Tiffany Hayes went down with 5:13 left in the second quarter after a collision but later returned. The Valkyries had lost two in a row and led by as many as 18 but were threatened in this one after Phoenix's 29-point third quarter cut the lead to 66-61 going into the final 10 minutes.

Alyssa Thomas started and finished with 22 points, nine assists and eight rebounds for the Mercury after dealing with a left calf injury and missing Friday's game at Portland. She was whistled for a technical foul 1:47 before halftime, then Kahleah Copper got a technical with 56 seconds remaining.

Monique Akoa Makani scored 19 points and Natasha Mack grabbed 10 rebounds for Phoenix, which had won two straight following a six-game skid. The Mercury, who lost 95-79 at Chase Center on May 10 in the Valkyries' home opener, committed 16 turnovers that led to 17 points for Golden State. The teams will face off again July 29 in Phoenix.

HEAD COACH NATALIE NAKASE



SCHOOL: UCLA - '03 **EXPERIENCE:** 2nd Season

Natalie Nakase is in her second season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces.

Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

In her first season at the helm of the Valkyries, Nakase led Golden State to 23 regular season wins during its inaugural year, a WNBA single-season record by an expansion team, and the Valkyries became the first-ever expansion franchise to reach the playoffs in their inaugural season. In June 2025, Nakase was named the league's Coach of the Month after the Valkyries went 7-4 (.636), and had three wins by 24 points or more.

Under Nakase and her staff, the Valkyries posted one of the best defenses in the WNBA, leading the league in opponent points per game (76.3) and opponent field goal percentage (40.5), while having the third-best defensive rating (99.8). Offensively, Golden State ranked top five in the WNBA in rebounds per game (35.3), three pointers made (427), and free throw percentage (81.5) during the regular season.

Following the season, Nakase was named the 2025 State Street Investment Management SPY WNBA Coach of the Year as well as the Associated Press Coach of the Year. Under Nakase's leadership, many Valkyries reached new career heights during the 2025 season, including Veronica Burton, who earned 2025 Kia WNBA Most Improved Player honors, Kayla Thornton, who was selected as a WNBA All-Star, and Janelle Salaün, who was named to the WNBA All-Rookie Team.

Nakase spent three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in 2023, with a rating of 97.7. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). She then served as an assistant coach for the Tokyo Apache for one season (2010-11) in the Men's Professional Basketball Japan League, followed by acting as head coach for the Saitama Broncos from 2011-12, making her the first woman to serve as head coach in the league.

Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology. After graduation, she played professionally for two years in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) with the San Jose Spiders and San Diego Siege. Nakase also competed for one season in Germany, where she suffered a career-ending knee injury in 2008.
