Sparks Connections

• Valkyries head coach Natalie Nakase was an assistant coach with Las Vegas from 2022-24 while Sparks guard Kelsey Plum and forward Dearica Hamby were with the Aces. The trio led Las Vegas to a WNBA Championship in 2022, and Nakase and Plum repeated in 2023.

• Sparks guard Kate Martin was selected by Golden State in the 2024 WNBA Expansion Draft. Martin played in 42 games for the Valkyries last season, averaging 6.2 points, 2.7 rebounds, and 1.0 assists per game.

• Martin also played under then-assistant coach Natalie Nakase in 2024 with Las Vegas.

• Los Angeles' Cameron Brink and Golden State's Ashton Prechtel led Stanford to the 2021 NCAA title.

• Five players between the Valkyries and Sparks played basketball at Stanford, headlined by Golden State's Nadia Fingall and Los Angeles' Cameron Brink and Nneka Ogwumike.

Notes

• Golden State had a 2025 season for the history books. The Valkyries set the record for wins by an expansion team (23), became the first-ever WNBA expansion team to reach the postseason during its inaugural season, and secured a winning record during its inaugural season.

• Kaitlyn Chen, Tiffany Hayes, Kiah Stokes and Gabby Williams give the Valkyries four former UConn players on the roster, the most former Huskies on any roster in the WNBA.

• The Valkyries boast the most returners this year of any other WNBA team, bringing back nine players who saw minutes in a Golden State uniform from a year ago.

• The Valkyries' 13 home wins are the most in the WNBA, and their 76.5 home winning percentage is the best in the league.

• Golden State has the second (after Dallas) easiest strength of schedule remaining, with opponents boasting a 45.7 winning percentage. The Valkyries have four games against current playoff teams (2 vs. MIN, 1 vs. DAL, 1 vs. NY).

• Golden State is allowing a WNBA-low 77.1 PPG on the year, including just 74.9 PPG its last 10 games (8-2 record). Valkyries opponents are shooting just 43.0 percent from the floor, and 29.4 percent from deep the last 10 games while averaging 15.8 turnovers. The Valkyries have allowed 70 or fewer points nine times this season.

• The Valkyries are allowing a league-low 33.8 PPG in the first half of games this season (next best is 40.2 by LVA), including 14.4 PPG and 35.2 FG% in the second quarter, both league bests. Golden State opponents are shooting just 40.4 percent from the field in the first half of games (lowest in the league). The Valkyries are 18-5 this year when allowing 40 points or fewer in the first half this season.

• The Valkyries are 16-2 when they dish out more assists than their opponent, and, 15-1 when Veronica Burton hands out six or more assists in a game. Golden State's 69.6 assist percentage in wins is the third highest in the league.

• Veronica Burton is 10th in the W with 5.6 assists per game, and first with a 3.63 assist-to-turnover ratio (min 10 GP). Burton is posting a 4.60 a/to in wins this season (third in the W). Burton is one of three players in the W this season averaging over 12.0 PPG, 5.0 APG while posting no more than 2.0 turnovers per game (also Paige Bueckers, Jessica Shepard).

• At 27.1 points per game, Veronica Burton is 15th in the league in points created (points per game and assisted points per game). Burton's 14.6 APC ranks seventh in the W.

• Kaitlyn Chen is shooting 53.9 percent from the floor (10th best in the league). Chen's 5.06 PPG improvement from a year ago is 17th best in the league this season, while her 2.08 FGM differential is 11th best.

• Salaün leads all bench players in total points (412; 100+ more than the next highest player) while Hayes ranks fourth (222) and Chen ranks fifth (219), giving the trio a league-high combined 853 points on the year.

• Kiah Stokes is second in the league with 1.9 BPG (trailing just A'ja Wilson), and leads all centers with a 2.47 a/to. Stokes is second in the position with a defensive rating of 96.9 (min. 10 GP). Stokes is one of 31 players all-time with over 1,000 points, 300 blocks and 200 assists, including one of 10 active players.

• Laetitia Amihire is 10th in the league with a defensive rating of 98.0 (min 10 GP), and is sixth in BPG by a reserve (0.8). Stokes and Amihire are key reasons why Golden State leads the WNBA in allowing the fewest points in the paint at just 32.5.

• Janelle Salaün became the ninth-fastest player all-time to reach 100 career threes (49 games) on 6/12 against Seattle. Salaün has made five threes in four games this season, and is sixth in the W with 78 total threes on the year (also is No. 1 among bench players). Salaün is third in the league with a 40.0 3FG% (among players with at least 5.0 3PA per game and 5 GP), and leads all bench players in the category (min. 5 GP). The Valkyries are 7-1 when Salaün makes four or more threes in a game this year.

• Golden State is a perfect 8-0 this season when Salaün scores 18 or more points, and the Valkyries are 15-1 when she shoots better than 40% from the field in a game.

• The league's next Sixth Player of the Year, Janelle Salaün has already drained the most three-pointers by a reserve player in a season in league history with 78 and counting. Her average of 2.5 made threes per game is currently a WNBA record by a reserve player. Salaün's 6 20-point games are tied for the fourth most by a reserve player in a season (record is 8 set in 2021 by Kelsey Plum). Additionally, Salaün's 13.3 PPG off the bench is currently the sixth best in league history and leads

all reserves in the W this year. The WNBA record for bench points per game in a season is 15.8 by Candice Wiggins in 2008 (457 total points).

• Golden State is 17-3 this season when tied or leading after three quarters.

• On Friday against the Wings, Veronica Burton led the Valkyries in scoring with 22 points, seven assists and zero turnovers. It was her second straight game with 10+ points, 5+ assists and 0 turnovers, the first time in her career she's put together that statline in consecutive games. It's the sixth such instance of 20+ points, 7+ assists and 0 turnovers in the W this season, and the second in Burton's career. Burton is averaging 17.0 points, 4.7 rebounds, 6.7 assists, a 50.0 FG% and 41.2% from three her last three games.

• Burton has seven games since the start of 2025 with 10+ points, 5+ assists and 0 turnovers, tied with Courtney Williams for the most in the W in that span.

• GSV continues to lead the league in bench points at 35.7 PPG, 4.3 made threes per game, and is third in the W with a 35.8 3FG% from the bench. Janelle Salaün's 13.3 PPG leads the WNBA in bench points per game (min 5 GP). The Valkyries have gotten 30 or more bench points in 21 games this season. Golden State is 9-2 when getting 40-or-more bench points in a game this year. The WNBA record for bench points per game in a season is 35.0 (LVA - 2020).

• The Valkyries currently rank second in the league in total threes (336) and first in made threes per game (10.8), and are sixth in 3FG% (35.3), and are second in first half threes per game (5.8). Golden State is averaging 11.4 made threes per game at home (highest in the league and highest by any team since 2023 (NYL - 11.7)). A league-high 39.0 percent of Golden State's points come from three (currently the highest mark in league history - next best is 38.4 in 2021 by NYL). The Valkyries are 13-6 this season when making double-digit threes. The WNBA record for average made threes in a game is 11.1 (NYL in 2023), and threes in a season is 444 (NYL in 2023).

• Golden State has ten games with 13 or more made threes this season, trailing just New York for the most in the league.

• The Valkyries have six games since the start of the 2025 season with 15 or more made threes, the most games in the league. Golden State's 751 total threes over that span are the most in the WNBA. Janelle Salaün's 140 made threes since the start of the 2025 season are the ninth most in the W.

• Janelle Salaün is 10th in the league with 76 NET points, while Veronica Burton is 16th with 46 and Gabby Williams ranks 18th with 44. Salaün's 5.8 NET per 80 possessions is third highest in the league.

• Golden State has four players in the top 25 of defensive win share (min 10 GP): No. 1 Burton - 0.191, No. 8 Thornton - 0.163, No. 12 Stokes - 0.160, No. 15 Williams - 0.156. Burton is eighth in overall winshare at 4.7.

• Last Sunday against the Tempo, Tiffany Hayes passed Hall of Famer and former teammate Swin Cash for 28th on the league's all-time scoring list, and now sits at 5,149 career points. Hayes is 10th among active players in career points.

• On Friday at Dallas, Kayla Thornton reached 2,500 career points. Thornton now has the fourth-most points ever by an undrafted player who debuted since 2000.

• GSV is averaging 94.0 PPG their last three games. It's the first time in team history the Valkyries have scored 90+ in three consecutive contests.

SAN FRANCISCO -- — Gabby Williams scored 16 points, Kaila Charles came of the bench to finish with 13 points, eight rebounds and five assists, and the Golden State Valkyries beat the Los Angeles Sparks 78-58 on Monday night for their third straight win.

Rae Burrell scored 13 points for the Sparks while Kelsey Plum and Nneka Ogwumike were held to nine points apiece in an off night shooting for Los Angeles, which had a three-game winning streak snapped.

Forward Cameron Brink went down hard in the closing minutes and was helped to the bench with an apparent ankle injury, though coach Lynne Roberts didn't have immediate details other than, "she's getting evaluated right now." Brink walked out of the locker room postgame on her own. Charles scored the final seven points of the first half and went 5 of 7 from the floor overall with two 3-pointers for Golden State, helping the Valkyries build a 45-26 lead at the break. Veronica Burton scored 12 points and Cecilia Zandalasini contributed 10 for the Valkyries.

They made eight of their first 13 shots to take a quick lead and 25-10 advantage after one quarter. They pushed the ball inside all game for 36 points in the paint and scored 30 bench points.

Sparks guard Kate Martin received a warm welcome back — a video tribute and rousing ovation from the sellout crowd at Chase Center — after she played the inaugural 2025 season for Golden State and started this year with the team.

She had three points, three rebounds and a pair of assists in 11 minutes.

Golden State jumped out to an 8-0 lead making three of its first six shots while Los Angeles missed its first five before Plum hit a 3 with 6:43 left in the opening quarter.

Veteran and former Stanford star Ogwumike missed her first three shots as Los Angeles began 3 of 13 and 1 for 6 from deep. The Sparks wound up 33.3% on field goals.

HEAD COACH NATALIE NAKASE



SCHOOL: UCLA - '03 **EXPERIENCE:** 2nd Season

Natalie Nakase is in her second season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces.

Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

In her first season at the helm of the Valkyries, Nakase led Golden State to 23 regular season wins during its inaugural year, a WNBA single-season record by an expansion team, and the Valkyries became the first-ever expansion franchise to reach the playoffs in their inaugural season. In June 2025, Nakase was named the league's Coach of the Month after the Valkyries went 7-4 (.636), and had three wins by 24 points or more.

Under Nakase and her staff, the Valkyries posted one of the best defenses in the WNBA, leading the league in opponent points per game (76.3) and opponent field goal percentage (40.5), while having the third-best defensive rating (99.8). Offensively, Golden State ranked top five in the WNBA in rebounds per game (35.3), three pointers made (427), and free throw percentage (81.5) during the regular season.

Following the season, Nakase was named the 2025 State Street Investment Management SPY WNBA Coach of the Year as well as the Associated Press Coach of the Year. Under Nakase's leadership, many Valkyries reached new career heights during the 2025 season, including Veronica Burton, who earned 2025 Kia WNBA Most Improved Player honors, Kayla Thornton, who was selected as a WNBA All-Star, and Janelle Salaün, who was named to the WNBA All-Rookie Team.

Nakase spent three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in 2023, with a rating of 97.7. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). She then served as an assistant coach for the Tokyo Apache for one season (2010-11) in the Men's Professional Basketball Japan League, followed by acting as head coach for the Saitama Broncos from 2011-12, making her the first woman to serve as head coach in the league.

Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology. After graduation, she played professionally for two years in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) with the San Jose Spiders and San Diego Siege. Nakase also competed for one season in Germany, where she suffered a career-ending knee injury in 2008.
