TEAM NOTES

The **Toronto Tempo** are in Atlanta to face the Dream in a rematch and the third and final game of a three-game road trip...on Friday, the team completed their biggest comeback of the season (16) to defeat the Connecticut Sun at Mohegan Sun, snapping a three-game losing streak and moving to 8-8 on the season (.500). The team recorded 19 three-point field goals, the most of any team in the league so far this season and tied for the second most ever by a team in a regular season game.

Chef Mabrey: Marina Mabrey returned to her former team and scored a career-high 37 points — including nine three-point field goals — tied for an all-time WNBA record. Mabrey's 37 points marks the fifth-highest scoring game in the league this season. 21 of her 37 points came in the fourth quarter to help power the Tempo to a victory.

Temi Time: Temi Fágbenlé had her best game of the season since returning from a shoulder injury, dropping a career-high 19 points and adding nine rebounds, just one shy of the team's first double-double.

María Magic: María Conde also had a new career-high, recording 19 points off the bench and five three-point field goals. She also added six rebounds, three assists, and a block on zero turnovers, providing quite the spark off the bench.

Izzy Harrison added 15 points, six rebounds, and five assists while **Julie Allemand** dished out a season-high nine assists.

Marina Mabrey scored a career-high 37 points and tied the WNBA single-game record with nine 3-pointers and the expansion Toronto Tempo overcame a 16-point deficit in the second half to beat the Connecticut Sun 101-97 on Friday night ... Mabrey scored 21 of her points in the fourth quarter as the Tempo made their big comeback ... She was 9 of 12 overall from 3-point range and had four rebounds and four assists ... Temi Fagbenle shot 8 for 9 from the floor and finished with 19 points and had nine rebounds ... Maria Conde also scored 19 points and had six rebounds off the bench ... Connecticut jumped out to a 50-37 halftime lead, but Toronto outscored the Sun 64-47 in the second half to pull away down the stretch and snap a three-game skid ... Kennedy Burke scored 18 points off the bench for the Sun, who have lost seven in a row ... Leila Lacan and Brittney Griner had 16, while Olivia Nelson-Ododa scored 13.

Kelsey Mitchell scored 27 points on 9-of-11 shooting, Caitlin Clark and Aliyah Boston each had a double-double, and the Indiana Fever beat the Toronto Tempo 113-91 on Tuesday night for their fourth straight victory ... Clark finished with 21 points and 14 assists, and Boston had 18 points and 11 rebounds ... Sophie Cunningham came off the bench to add a season-high 24 points with six 3-pointers ... Laura Juskaite led Toronto (7-8) with 19 points and Marina Mabrey added 18 ... Maria Conde scored 12, Isabelle Harrison and Brittney Sykes each had 11 and Kia Nurse added 10 ... Indiana (9-5) set a franchise record for points in regulation, shooting 52% from the field, including 13 of 30 on 3-pointers, and 28 of 33 at the free-throw line ... Mitchell and Cunningham combined for 21 of Indiana's 32 points in the third quarter, while Toronto scored just 23 ... All nine of Cunningham's points in the frame came on 3-pointers ... Cunningham made Indiana's 10th 3-pointer with 7.4 seconds left in the third for an 85-73 lead and added another to begin the fourth for a 15-point advantage ... She finished 6 of 7 from 3-point range and Mitchell went 3 for 4 ... Sykes was helped off the court in the first half with an apparent leg injury and did not return ... Julie Allemand (headache) was also limited to just 11 minutes ... The Tempo were already without Nyara Sabally (hamstring) and Kiki Rice (left ankle).

Angel Reese had 15 points and 17 rebounds — which included a career-high 11 offensive, one short of tying the WNBA single-game record — and the Atlanta Dream beat the Toronto Tempo 102-77 on Sunday ... Reese, who came in averaging 14.6 points and a league-leading 11.9 rebounds, has nine double-doubles this season and 59 in her career, the most in WNBA history through 76 games ... Reese, acquired April 6 from Chicago in a trade for two first-round picks, has 17 rebounds in three of the past four games ... Reese's 11 offensive rebounds were one shy of the franchise mark set by Sancho Lyttle, who shares the WNBA's single-game record with Glory Johnson, Nneka Ogwumike and Cheryl Ford ... Allisha Gray added 26 points and seven assists for the Dream (9-4) and Rhyne Howard had 24 points and three blocks ... Rookie second-round pick Isobel Borlase shot 5 of 6 from the field and scored a career-high 17 points ... Gray made five 3-pointers and moved past Angel McCoughtry (233) into third place in franchise history with 235 career 3s. Howard, who made four from behind the arc, has a franchise-record 408 career 3-pointers ... Atlanta — which shot just 6 of 25 (24%) from the field, including 1 of 12 from behind the arc, in the first quarter as the Tempo opened a 12-point lead — shot 64% (11 of 17) overall, made each of its four 3-point shots and had nine assists in the second ... Gray had 11 points and four assists as Atlanta outscored the Tempo 34-14 in the second period, the Dream's highest-scoring quarter this season ... Toronto's Isabelle Harrison scored 17 points before she was called for a flagrant foul 2 and ejected about four minutes into the third following a hard foul on Reese ... Julie Allemand had 13 points, six assists, two steals and two blocks for the Tempo (7-7) ... Toronto's Nyara Sabally (hamstring) missed her second consecutive game.

Sonia Citron scored 17 points and made the winning jumper as time expired, rookie Lauren Betts scored a season-high 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting and the Washington Mystics beat the Toronto Tempo 86-85 on Friday night ... Betts, the No. 4 overall pick in the draft, played a career-high 21 minutes in the absence of second-year forward Kiki Iriafen (ankle) ... Michaela Onyenwere also scored 17 points for the Mystics (5-6) ... Shakira Austin had 12 points and 11 rebounds for her fifth double-double this season ... The fifth-year center also had a career-high nine turnovers, the most in a WNBA game this season ... Washington had a season-high 22 turnovers and were 2 of 18 from 3-point range ... Marina Mabrey scored 18 of her 27 points in the fourth quarter for the Tempo (7-6) ... Brittney Sykes added 20 points ... Mabrey, who shot 5 of 10 from behind the arc, has 473 career 3-pointers and moved past Shekinna Stricklen (468) for 23rd place in WNBA history ... The expansion Tempo had a season-high 18 steals, the most in WNBA since 2025 (Seattle, 20) ... Betts scored inside with 3:21 to play to give the Mystics a 14-point lead ... Mabrey made three free throws and assisted on a layup before she hit two 3s in a 25-second span to make it a two-possession game with 1:51 left ... Mabrey then converted a four-point play and hit a pull-up 3-pointer to take an 84-83 with 31.6 left, but Sykes answered 20 seconds later with a driving layup — her only points in the second half ... Betts had deep position under the basket, but got tied up with 2.1 seconds left before she tipped the ensuing jump ball to Citron for the winning fadeaway jumper ... Nyara Sabally, averaging a career-high 12.4 points on 56% shooting for Toronto this season, didn't play due to a hamstring injury.

SANDY BRONDELLO COACHING STAFF

A two-time WNBA Champion and one of the most accomplished coaches in international basketball, Sandy Brondello enters the inaugural season of the Toronto Tempo as the first Head Coach in franchise history. Widely respected for her championship pedigree, player-centred leadership style, and ability to build a sustainable winning culture, Brondello brings decades of experience across the WNBA and global game to Canada's first WNBA franchise. Brondello joined the Tempo following more than a decade of success as a WNBA head coach, leading the Phoenix Mercury (2014–2021) and New York Liberty (2022–2025) to four WNBA Finals appearances. She captured her first WNBA championship in 2014 with Phoenix, earning WNBA Coach of the Year honours in her debut season with the club, and added a second title in 2024 with New York. She is one of only two coaches in league history to win championships with multiple franchises and currently ranks sixth all-time in WNBA career wins and games coached, and second in playoff victories. In addition to her success at the professional level, Brondello has served as Head Coach of the Australian Women's National Team since 2017. Under her leadership, the Opals earned a bronze medal at the 2024 Paris Olympic Games, continuing her long-standing impact on the international stage. As a head coach, she has guided Australia at multiple Olympic Games and FIBA World Cups, reinforcing her reputation as one of the premier coaches in the global women's game. Before transitioning into coaching, Brondello enjoyed an illustrious playing career spanning nearly two decades. A native of Mackay, Queensland, she represented Australia at four Olympic Games, winning three medals (bronze in 1996; silver in 2000 and 2004), and is regarded as one of the country's all-time great shooting guards. She was named the WNBL Most Valuable Player in 1995 and competed professionally in Australia, Germany, and the WNBA, where she was selected to the league's first-ever All-Star Game in 1999. Following her playing career, Brondello moved seamlessly into coaching, beginning as an assistant with the San Antonio Silver Stars before later serving as an assistant with the Los Angeles Sparks. She earned her first WNBA head coaching opportunity in 2010, and ultimately established herself among the league's elite during her eight-season tenure in Phoenix, where her teams reached the playoffs every year and won a league title. Brondello was inducted into the Australian Basketball Hall of Fame in 2010, recognizing her exceptional contributions to the sport as both a player and coach. Known for her collaborative approach, defensive discipline, and emphasis on accountability and team culture, she brings a proven blueprint for success as the Tempo prepare to compete in their inaugural WNBA season.
