TEAM NOTES

The **Toronto Tempo** will play their first of three games this season at Scotiabank Arena with a matchup against the Phoenix Mercury after earning their largest win of the season with a 28-point victory against the LA Sparks, 125-97 (+28). Their 125 points are the most in any regulation game in WNBA history. They led by as many as 35 points, their largest margin of the season. Toronto also crashed the glass for a season-high 52 total rebounds, just the second team to record 50+ rebounds this season. The Tempo are also the first team this season to have 20+ three-point field goals in a game.

Money Mabrey: Marina Mabrey solidified her All-Star case with a career-high 53 points, tied for the most in a game in WNBA history - including nine three-point field goals, tied for a WNBA record (which she previously hit last week). She scored 19 points in the first quarter and now holds three of the highest scoring quarters on the league this season. Mabrey is 21-for-38 in her last three games, shooting 55 percent from three and has recorded 21 three-point field goals in that stretch, marking the most on a three-game span in WNBA history. She leads the WNBA in fourth quarter scoring this season.

Assisting Allemand: Julie Allemand dished out a career-high 14 assists along with 13 points for a double-double on zero turnovers, tied for the most assists in league history on no turnovers. Her 14 assists also led to 35 points for the team. Three other players finished in double-digits, including **María Conde** (13), **Kia Nurse** (12), and **Laura Juškaitė** (10).

Marina Mabrey matched the WNBA scoring record with 53 points to help the Toronto Tempo rout the Los Angeles Sparks 125-97 on Thursday night ... Mabrey tied the mark set by Liz Cambage for Dallas against New York on July 17, 2018, and by A'ja Wilson for Las Vegas at Atlanta on Aug. 22, 2023 ... Mabrey said she was unaware of the scoring record until sister Michaela Mabrey, sitting on the sideline, told her she was three points away ... "There's no stat board in our gym," Mabrey said ... "After you get into a state like that, it's kind of hard to know what you're really doing, but my teammates made it known, so I knew I was doing something good" ... When she checked out with a minute remaining, fans briefly booed the substitution before erupting into cheers in acknowledgment of her big night ... The clock ticked down to zero with chants of "We want Mabrey! We want Mabrey!" ... Mabrey also had six rebounds and two assists ... She has been red-hot over the past three games, totaling 113 points, the most in a three-game span in WNBA history ... Julie Allemand added 13 points and 14 assists for Toronto in the highest-scoring game in the team's short history ... "Julie literally throws the ball right to my pocket, it's actually wild," Mabrey said ... Nneka Ogumike and Dearica Hamby led the Sparks with 21 points apiece ... Toronto climbed back to .500 at 9-9, and Los Angeles fell to 8-9 ... The Tempo opened a nine-game homestand that includes two games at Montreal's Bell Centre.

Rhyne Howard scored 20 points, Allisha Gray and rookie Madina Okot each added 18, and the Atlanta Dream beat the Toronto Tempo 94-87 on Monday night for their fourth straight victory ... Gray and Okot each scored 16 points in the first half to help Atlanta build a 59-41 lead ... Howard's fifth and final 3-pointer gave Atlanta a 71-54 lead with 5:21 left in the third quarter ... The Dream led by as many as 23 in the game ... Jordin Canada had 11 points and 13 assists for her second straight double-double, and Angel Reese also finished with 11 points for Atlanta (12-4) ... Okot, who eclipsed her previous best of 14 points, finished 7 of 9 from the floor to go with seven rebounds off the bench ... Marina Mabrey had 23 points for Toronto (8-9), and Isabelle Harrison scored 21 to go with 10 rebounds ... Temi Fagbenle added 10 points off the bench ... Atlanta is 8-2 in its last 10 games to sit atop the Eastern Conference.

Kelsey Mitchell scored 27 points on 9-of-11 shooting, Caitlin Clark and Aliyah Boston each had a double-double, and the Indiana Fever beat the Toronto Tempo 113-91 on Tuesday night for their fourth straight victory ... Clark finished with 21 points and 14 assists, and Boston had 18 points and 11 rebounds ... Sophie Cunningham came off the bench to add a season-high 24 points with six 3-pointers ... Laura Juskaite led Toronto (7-8) with 19 points and Marina Mabrey added 18 ... Maria Conde scored 12, Isabelle Harrison and Brittney Sykes each had 11 and Kia Nurse added 10 ... Indiana (9-5) set a franchise record for points in regulation, shooting 52% from the field, including 13 of 30 on 3-pointers, and 28 of 33 at the free-throw line ... Mitchell and Cunningham combined for 21 of Indiana's 32 points in the third quarter, while Toronto scored just 23 ... All nine of Cunningham's points in the frame came on 3-pointers ... Cunningham made Indiana's 10th 3-pointer with 7.4 seconds left in the third for an 85-73 lead and added another to begin the fourth for a 15-point advantage ... She finished 6 of 7 from 3-point range and Mitchell went 3 for 4 ... Sykes was helped off the court in the first half with an apparent leg injury and did not return ... Julie Allemand (headache) was also limited to just 11 minutes ... The Tempo were already without Nyara Sabally (hamstring) and Kiki Rice (left ankle).

SANDY BRONDELLO COACHING STAFF

A two-time WNBA Champion and one of the most accomplished coaches in international basketball, Sandy Brondello enters the inaugural season of the Toronto Tempo as the first Head Coach in franchise history. Widely respected for her championship pedigree, player-centred leadership style, and ability to build a sustainable winning culture, Brondello brings decades of experience across the WNBA and global game to Canada's first WNBA franchise. Brondello joined the Tempo following more than a decade of success as a WNBA head coach, leading the Phoenix Mercury (2014–2021) and New York Liberty (2022–2025) to four WNBA Finals appearances. She captured her first WNBA championship in 2014 with Phoenix, earning WNBA Coach of the Year honours in her debut season with the club, and added a second title in 2024 with New York. She is one of only two coaches in league history to win championships with multiple franchises and currently ranks sixth all-time in WNBA career wins and games coached, and second in playoff victories. In addition to her success at the professional level, Brondello has served as Head Coach of the Australian Women's National Team since 2017. Under her leadership, the Opals earned a bronze medal at the 2024 Paris Olympic Games, continuing her long-standing impact on the international stage. As a head coach, she has guided Australia at multiple Olympic Games and FIBA World Cups, reinforcing her reputation as one of the premier coaches in the global women's game. Before transitioning into coaching, Brondello enjoyed an illustrious playing career spanning nearly two decades. A native of Mackay, Queensland, she represented Australia at four Olympic Games, winning three medals (bronze in 1996; silver in 2000 and 2004), and is regarded as one of the country's all-time great shooting guards. She was named the WNBL Most Valuable Player in 1995 and competed professionally in Australia, Germany, and the WNBA, where she was selected to the league's first-ever All-Star Game in 1999. Following her playing career, Brondello moved seamlessly into coaching, beginning as an assistant with the San Antonio Silver Stars before later serving as an assistant with the Los Angeles Sparks. She earned her first WNBA head coaching opportunity in 2010, and ultimately established herself among the league's elite during her eight-season tenure in Phoenix, where her teams reached the playoffs every year and won a league title. Brondello was inducted into the Australian Basketball Hall of Fame in 2010, recognizing her exceptional contributions to the sport as both a player and coach. Known for her collaborative approach, defensive discipline, and emphasis on accountability and team culture, she brings a proven blueprint for success as the Tempo prepare to compete in their inaugural WNBA season.
