Kiki Iriafen had 25 points and 14 rebounds, Shakira Austin added 17 points and 10 rebounds, and the Washington Mystics beat the Toronto Tempo 79-62 on Tuesday night...The Mystics began the second half on an 11-3 run, capped by an Iriafen layup, to take their first lead, 37-35, since the midway point of the first quarter...Washington outscored Toronto 53-30 in the second half...Michaela Onyenwere added 15 points for Washington (12-10), which outrebounded Toronto 46-26 and got 20 second-chance points compared to the Tempo's three...All-Star Sonia Citron played 31 minutes and was held to just two points — the lowest scoring game of her two-year career...Julie Allemand led short-handed Toronto (10-14) with 15 points and Nyara Sabally added 13...Brittney Sykes (left plantar fascia), Kiki Rice (left ankle sprain) and Temi Fagbenle (concussion) did not play...Isabelle Harrison and All-Star Marina Mabrey had eight points apiece in the Tempo's lowest scoring game this season...Toronto's previous low was a 68-65 loss to Washington in its first regular-season game on May 8.

Marina Mabrey scored 30 points, Nyara Sabally made the tiebreaking basket with 52 seconds left after Toronto blew a 20-point lead, and the Tempo beat the New York Liberty 93-91 on Sunday at the Bell Centre...Mabrey had her second consecutive 30-point game and her fifth this season, including a 53-point performance — which tied the WNBA's single-game record — in a 125-97 win over Los Angeles on June 25...Breanna Stewart made a layup that tied it at 91-all with 1:30 to play, but Julie Allemand, who finished with 10 assists, found Sabally for the go-ahead layup as the Tempo snapped a four-game losing streak, the longest of their expansion season...Sabrina Ionescu scored 28 points and Stewart added 22 for the Liberty (13-11), who have lost seven of their last nine...Jonquel Jones had 10 points and 10 rebounds...Laura Juskaite had 18 points, Maria Conde scored 15 and Sabally had 13 for the Tempo (10-13), who led 74-54 late in the third quarter...The Liberty ripped off a 16-4 run as Toronto committed five turnovers that trimmed their deficit to 84-80 when Ionescu made a layup with 5:36 to play...The Tempo snapped a three-game skid in games which they led going into the final period. Toronto, which was outscored 27-13 in the final 10 minutes, has a minus-49 point differential in its last five fourth quarters...The Tempo lost 108-95 against Dallas despite 34 points from Mabrey on Friday night, also at the Bell Centre in front of a WNBA regular-season record crowd of 20,996...Toronto also plays two home games at the Rogers Arena in Vancouver, British Columbia, later this season...New York's Betnijah Laney-Hamilton was ejected in the closing minutes for throwing a shoe at Mabrey...Laney-Hamilton and Mabrey were hit with double technical fouls after a scuffle in the third quarter.

Paige Bueckers scored 34 points and the Dallas Wings beat the expansion Toronto Tempo 108-95 on Friday night in front of a WNBA regular-season record crowd of 20,996 at Bell Centre...The game broke the regular-season mark of 20,711 set in Washington on Sept. 19, 2024, against Indiana...The league's two largest crowds -- both 22,076 -- came in Detroit in the 2003 and 2007 WNBA Finals...Being the only team in Canada, it's a responsibility for us and how cool is that," Tempo coach Sandy Brondello said..."We get to be seen all over Canada. We want to make sure we can come out tonight and celebrate the WNBA and celebrate the Tempo with our new fans..."...Toronto will face New York in Montreal on Sunday...The Tempo also will play two games in Vancouver, British Columbia..."I said to the team today what a unique opportunity this is...We're creating firsts...We say we're Canada's team so we're taking the show on the road," Brondello said..."I always say, a fan has to just come and watch one game and they'll fall in love..."...Jessica Shepard had 20 points and 17 rebounds to help the Wings (15-8) sweep a four-game trip that also saw them beat the Tempo in Toronto...Arike Ogunbowale also had 20 points, and Azzi Fudd added 13...Bueckers was 13-of-22 from the field and had six assists and six rebounds...Marina Mabrey had 34 points for Toronto (9-13), hitting 6-of-9 3-pointers...Laura Juskaite added 25 points...The Tempo have lost four straight..."It's really special for Canada and for the Toronto Tempo franchise," said Dallas coach Jose Fernandez said..."It just shows the trajectory of where the WNBA is and what the franchise in Toronto is doing for basketball fans in Canada..."...The Bell Centre also hosted the largest crowd in Professional Women's Hockey League history, drawing 21,105 for a game between Montreal and Toronto on April 20, 2024.

SANDY BRONDELLO COACHING STAFF

A two-time WNBA Champion and one of the most accomplished coaches in international basketball, Sandy Brondello enters the inaugural season of the Toronto Tempo as the first Head Coach in franchise history. Widely respected for her championship pedigree, player-centred leadership style, and ability to build a sustainable winning culture, Brondello brings decades of experience across the WNBA and global game to Canada's first WNBA franchise. Brondello joined the Tempo following more than a decade of success as a WNBA head coach, leading the Phoenix Mercury (2014–2021) and New York Liberty (2022–2025) to four WNBA Finals appearances. She captured her first WNBA championship in 2014 with Phoenix, earning WNBA Coach of the Year honours in her debut season with the club, and added a second title in 2024 with New York. She is one of only two coaches in league history to win championships with multiple franchises and currently ranks sixth all-time in WNBA career wins and games coached, and second in playoff victories. In addition to her success at the professional level, Brondello has served as Head Coach of the Australian Women's National Team since 2017. Under her leadership, the Opals earned a bronze medal at the 2024 Paris Olympic Games, continuing her long-standing impact on the international stage. As a head coach, she has guided Australia at multiple Olympic Games and FIBA World Cups, reinforcing her reputation as one of the premier coaches in the global women's game. Before transitioning into coaching, Brondello enjoyed an illustrious playing career spanning nearly two decades. A native of Mackay, Queensland, she represented Australia at four Olympic Games, winning three medals (bronze in 1996; silver in 2000 and 2004), and is regarded as one of the country's all-time great shooting guards. She was named the WNBL Most Valuable Player in 1995 and competed professionally in Australia, Germany, and the WNBA, where she was selected to the league's first-ever All-Star Game in 1999. Following her playing career, Brondello moved seamlessly into coaching, beginning as an assistant with the San Antonio Silver Stars before later serving as an assistant with the Los Angeles Sparks. She earned her first WNBA head coaching opportunity in 2010, and ultimately established herself among the league's elite during her eight-season tenure in Phoenix, where her teams reached the playoffs every year and won a league title. Brondello was inducted into the Australian Basketball Hall of Fame in 2010, recognizing her exceptional contributions to the sport as both a player and coach. Known for her collaborative approach, defensive discipline, and emphasis on accountability and team culture, she brings a proven blueprint for success as the Tempo prepare to compete in their inaugural WNBA season.
