TEAM NOTES

The **Toronto Tempo** fell to the Golden State Valkyries on Sunday Night at Chase Center and have now lost six consecutive games....they will face the Valkyries once again on Tuesday before moving on to Portland, Atlanta, and Dallas on their five-game road trip.

Despite the loss, Toronto kept it to a two-possession game following most quarters and led by as many as five points. All starters scored in double-digits and were led by **Nyara Sabally**, who had 19 points and eight rebounds, just two boards shy of her second career-double-double. Rookie **Kiki Rice** had her best game since returning from a left ankle injury, scoring 16 points and adding five rebounds, three assists, and a steal in 27 minutes of play.

Laura Juškaitė added 15 points, **Julie Allemand** recorded 11 points and six assists, while **María Conde** finished with ten points, five, rebounds, and five assists. Former Valkyrie **Temi Fágbenlé** grabbed six rebounds off the bench.

Janelle Salaun came off the bench to score 24 points, Veronica Burton contributed 17 points and six assists, and the Golden State Valkyries used their stingy defense down the stretch to hold off the Toronto Tempo for a 96-79 win Sunday night...Gabby Williams and Tiffany Hayes scored 15 points apiece in the first of back-to-back matchups between the teams at Chase Center, where a raucous sellout crowd cheered Golden State ending a two-game skid that followed a nine-game winning streak...Salaun shot 9 for 15 with four 3-pointers, putting Golden State ahead 66-59 on a 3 with 1:30 left in the third...She just missed her career-high of 26 set July 8 at Toronto...Burton converted a three-point play with 6:55 remaining in the game then a steal with 6:14 remaining that led to Salaun's three-point play moments later that put the Valkyries ahead 80-68...Nyara Sabally had 19 points and eight rebounds for the expansion Tempo, who began a five-game road trip by losing their sixth straight game and 10th in their last 11...Toronto was missing leading scorer Marina Mabrey because of a neck injury...The Valkyries needed a big second half after squandering a double-digit lead late in the second quarter...They led 44-31 after Cecilia Zandalasini's 3-pointer with 2:34 left in the half but Toronto responded with a 12-0 run to pull within 44-43 at the break...Kiah Stokes got Golden State going in a hurry with a blocked shot on Toronto's initial possession, two quick rebounds and a layup...She finished with 11 rebounds, eight points and four blocks...The Valkyries shot 50% in the opening quarter, making 5 of 8 3-pointers, to build a 25-20 lead.

Napheesa Collier, Olivia Miles and Courtney Williams each scored 16 points and the Minnesota Lynx beat the Toronto Tempo 104-72 on Thursday night for their ninth straight victory...Kayla McBride added 13 points, Dorka Juhasz had 12 and Natasha Howard finished with nine points eight rebounds, three steals and two blocks for the WNBA-leading Lynx (24-6)...Laura Juskaite led the expansion Tempo (10-18) with 19 points...Marina Mabrey added 16, and Nyara Sabally had 10...Toronto has lost five straight, which includes a 100-93 loss at Minnesota in Collier's season debut Tuesday night, and nine of 10...Minnesota had a season-high 14 steals and scored 31 points off the Tempo's season-worst 24 turnovers...Collier scored seven points in a 20-6 second-quarter run that gave the Lynx a 14-point lead with 2:31 left and it was 50-41 at halftime...Miles, the No. 2 pick in the 2026 draft, did not have an assist for the first time in her WNBA career...Brittney Sykes (foot) and Isabelle Harrison (knee) did not play for Toronto.

Rookie Olivia Miles scored 24 points and the Minnesota Lynx extended their winning streak to eight games with a 100-93 victory over the Toronto Tempo on Tuesday night...Miles shot 9 for 17 with four 3-pointers for Minnesota (23-6), which owns the best record in the WNBA...She added eight assists and six rebounds...Kayla McBride scored 18 with four 3-pointers for the Lynx, who were 14 for 25 (56%) from distance...Napheesa Collier had 15 points and Natasha Howard scored 13...Reserve Antonia Delaere scored 12 on 4-for-5 shooting from distance...Marina Mabrey had 25 points, eight rebounds and six assists for Toronto (10-17), which has lost four straight and eight of its last nine...Maria Conde finished with 20 points and 10 rebounds, and Laura Juskaite scored 18...Miles made a layup to give the Lynx an 89-75 lead with 6:32 left to play...Juskaite and Kia Nurse hit back-to-back 3-pointers to end a 12-0 run and cut the deficit to two over the next 2:22...Delaere answered with two straight 3-pointers to increase the lead to 95-87 as Minnesota recovered...Miles had 15 points by halftime, McBride scored 13 and the Lynx took a 53-43 lead into the break after trailing 28-25 to start the second quarter.

SANDY BRONDELLO COACHING STAFF

A two-time WNBA Champion and one of the most accomplished coaches in international basketball, Sandy Brondello enters the inaugural season of the Toronto Tempo as the first Head Coach in franchise history. Widely respected for her championship pedigree, player-centred leadership style, and ability to build a sustainable winning culture, Brondello brings decades of experience across the WNBA and global game to Canada's first WNBA franchise. Brondello joined the Tempo following more than a decade of success as a WNBA head coach, leading the Phoenix Mercury (2014–2021) and New York Liberty (2022–2025) to four WNBA Finals appearances. She captured her first WNBA championship in 2014 with Phoenix, earning WNBA Coach of the Year honours in her debut season with the club, and added a second title in 2024 with New York. She is one of only two coaches in league history to win championships with multiple franchises and currently ranks sixth all-time in WNBA career wins and games coached, and second in playoff victories. In addition to her success at the professional level, Brondello has served as Head Coach of the Australian Women's National Team since 2017. Under her leadership, the Opals earned a bronze medal at the 2024 Paris Olympic Games, continuing her long-standing impact on the international stage. As a head coach, she has guided Australia at multiple Olympic Games and FIBA World Cups, reinforcing her reputation as one of the premier coaches in the global women's game. Before transitioning into coaching, Brondello enjoyed an illustrious playing career spanning nearly two decades. A native of Mackay, Queensland, she represented Australia at four Olympic Games, winning three medals (bronze in 1996; silver in 2000 and 2004), and is regarded as one of the country's all-time great shooting guards. She was named the WNBL Most Valuable Player in 1995 and competed professionally in Australia, Germany, and the WNBA, where she was selected to the league's first-ever All-Star Game in 1999. Following her playing career, Brondello moved seamlessly into coaching, beginning as an assistant with the San Antonio Silver Stars before later serving as an assistant with the Los Angeles Sparks. She earned her first WNBA head coaching opportunity in 2010, and ultimately established herself among the league's elite during her eight-season tenure in Phoenix, where her teams reached the playoffs every year and won a league title. Brondello was inducted into the Australian Basketball Hall of Fame in 2010, recognizing her exceptional contributions to the sport as both a player and coach. Known for her collaborative approach, defensive discipline, and emphasis on accountability and team culture, she brings a proven blueprint for success as the Tempo prepare to compete in their inaugural WNBA season.
